

SUSPECTED OVARIAN CANCER

- Persistent abdominal distention (bloating)
- increased urinary urgency &/or frequency (having excluded UTI and glucosurea)
- New onset symptoms suggestive of IBS
- Early satiety &/or loss of appetite
- Pelvic or abdominal pain

- Unexplained weight loss
- Changes in bowel habit
- Fatigue



Arrange an **URGENT (within 2 weeks) CA125 and ultrasound of abdomen and pelvis** (especially if ≥ 50 yr) if any of these symptoms are present persistently or frequently



Consider CA125 and ultrasound of abdomen and pelvis at any age

Please include CA125 result if referring as CA125 level is needed to calculate risk of malignancy index
